DAYS OF PRAYER

Genesis 16:13

¹³ So she called the name of the Lord who spoke to her, "You are a God of seeing," for she said, "Truly here I have seen him who looks after me."

Genesis 21:17-20

¹⁷ And God heard the voice of the boy, and the angel of God called to Hagar from heaven and said to her, "What troubles you, Hagar? Fear not, for God has heard the voice of the boy where he is. ¹⁸ Up! Lift up the boy, and hold him fast with your hand, for I will make him into a great nation." ¹⁹ Then God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water. And she went and filled the skin with water and gave the boy a drink. ²⁰ And God was with the boy, and he grew up. He lived in the wilderness and became an expert with the bow.

Big Idea

In this session we will examine the Life of Hagar. Over the course of her life, Hagar found herself in some difficult and even life-threatening situations. Yet it's in those moments that God revealed 3 very powerful things about his nature. God sees, God hears, and God provides. We can be encouraged by Hagar story, because we can be confident that no matter what we are walking through, God sees us, He hears us, and He can provide for us.

- How does it change the way that you pray when you are reminded that God hears you?
