

21 DAYS OF PRAYER

Matthew 6:9-13 (ESV)

“Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. ¹⁰ Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. ¹¹ Give us this day our daily bread ¹² and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. ¹³ And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Big Idea

Scripture calls us to hallow God in our prayers. This means to look at God in the way of how he is most beautiful and most worthy. To hallow God, we need to be intentional. This starts with slowing down in our prayer life. That gives us the time to focus on who he is. Then we can worship our God who is worthy of it all.
