Look for bold, colorful illustrations or photographs with simple or no text. Select books that contain familiar objects, animals or other babies. Also, look for books that repeat, rhyme or have rhythm.

Preschoolers enjoy books with large colorful illustrations as well as small detailed drawings. Look for books that invite interaction like I Spy, counting, ABC's, or wordless books.

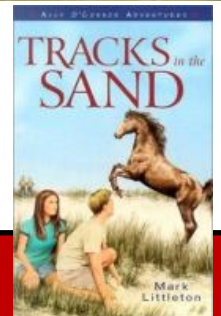
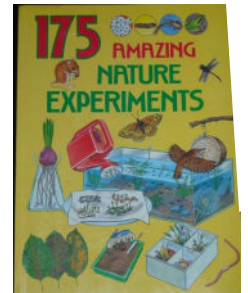
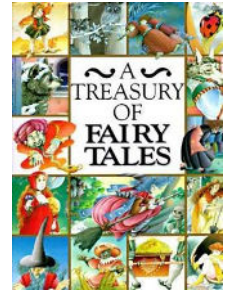
