Volunteer opportunities in the Library

Come join the Liberty Library Staff, training offered in all areas. Join our team and work with us as we keep the library attractive and up-to-date.

Filing or Shelving Items: Many items are returned each week. These need to be shelved correctly so that the next patron will be able to find them.

Circulation desk: Welcoming people into the library, and helping them find the items they are looking for. Knowledgeable and comfortable with using the computer for searches, checking out items, or checking in returned items.

Processing: Entering new items into the computer, and preparing them for circulation. Requires computer knowledge and skills for entering data and printing labels. Each paperback book is also covered with laminate to prolong their shelf life. Dustjackets are also covered, to help keep them attractive.

Repair: Sometimes things happen and books will need a little TLC before the next patron borrows them.

Storytime: Join the Storytime team, reading and doing crafts with young children to instill a love of books and having a good time in the library. Storytime is at 4:30 pm each Wednesday.

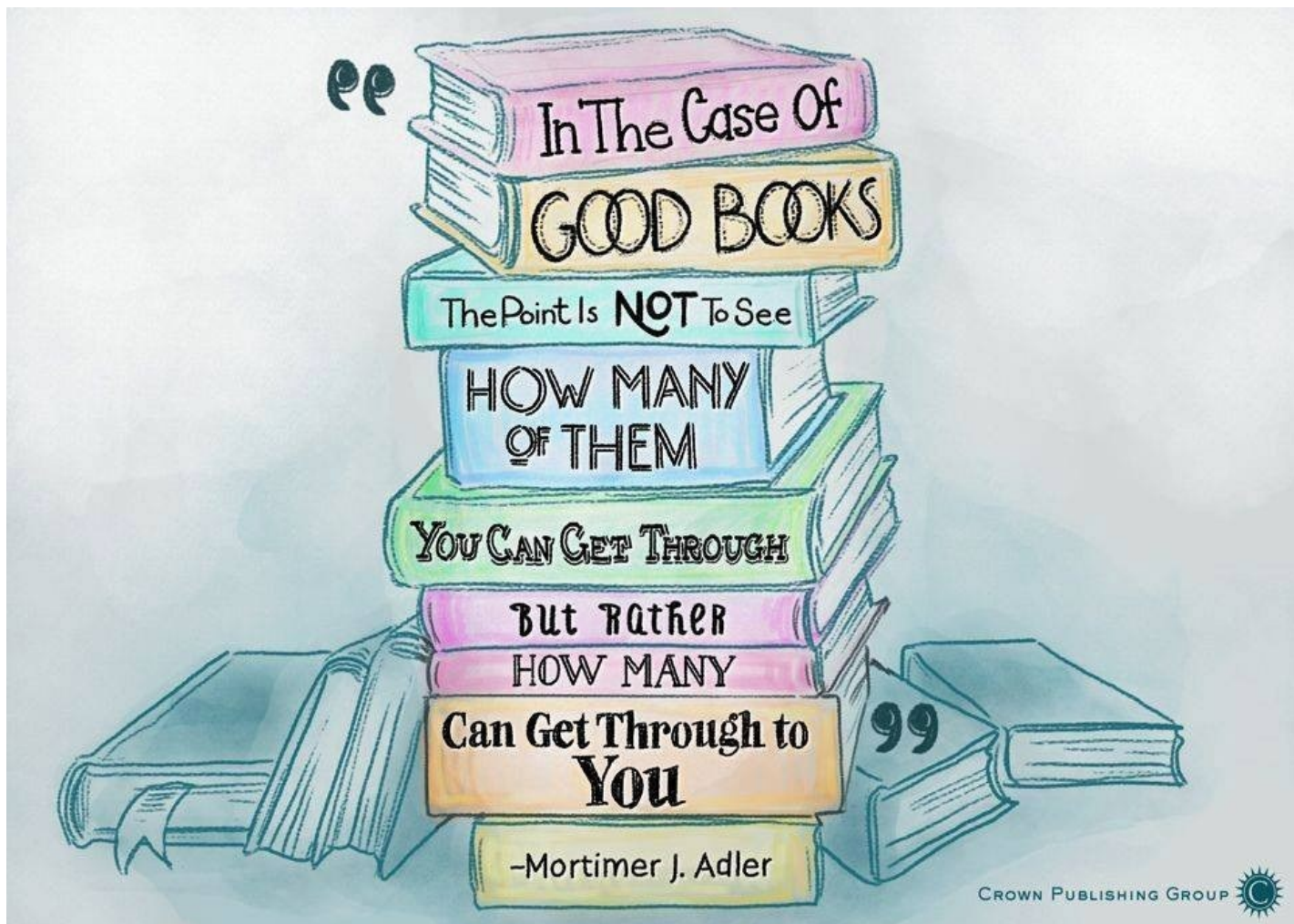
Library Material Selection Policy

All materials are subject to approval by the Library staff and church leadership. The focus of selection will be materials that support the various church programs, nurture the believer, proclaim the gospel, and call us to minister and worship the Lord Jesus Christ.

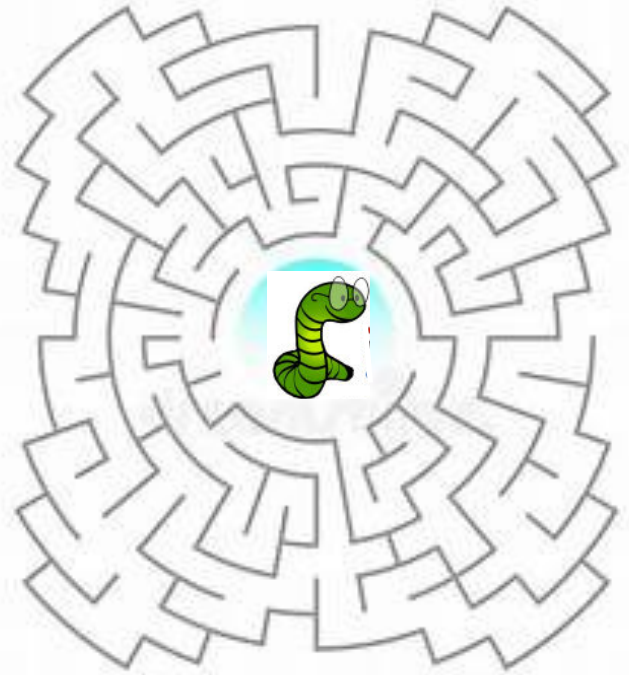
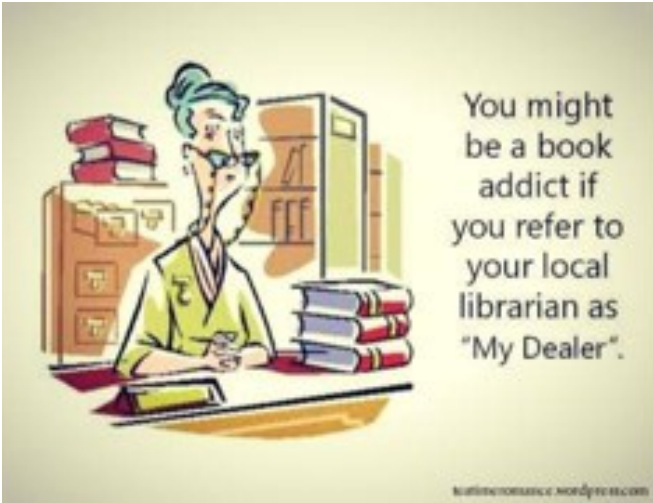
Materials will be of sound doctrine, scriptural interpretation, constructive in influence and morally sound. They will support our belief in the development of the individual and Christian lifestyles.

Gift Policy

The most common and preferred gift is monetary, which is used for the purchase of new materials or furnishings. The donor and Library staff may determine specific needs regarding the choice of gift. Donations of gently used or new materials are accepted and must meet the same standards of the Selection Policy. Items may be added to the Library collection, disbursed to mission locations, other church libraries, or to persons needing resources. Copyright should be no more than 10 years, except for classics. Unless specified, donations will not be returned to the donor and provisional gifts will not be accepted.

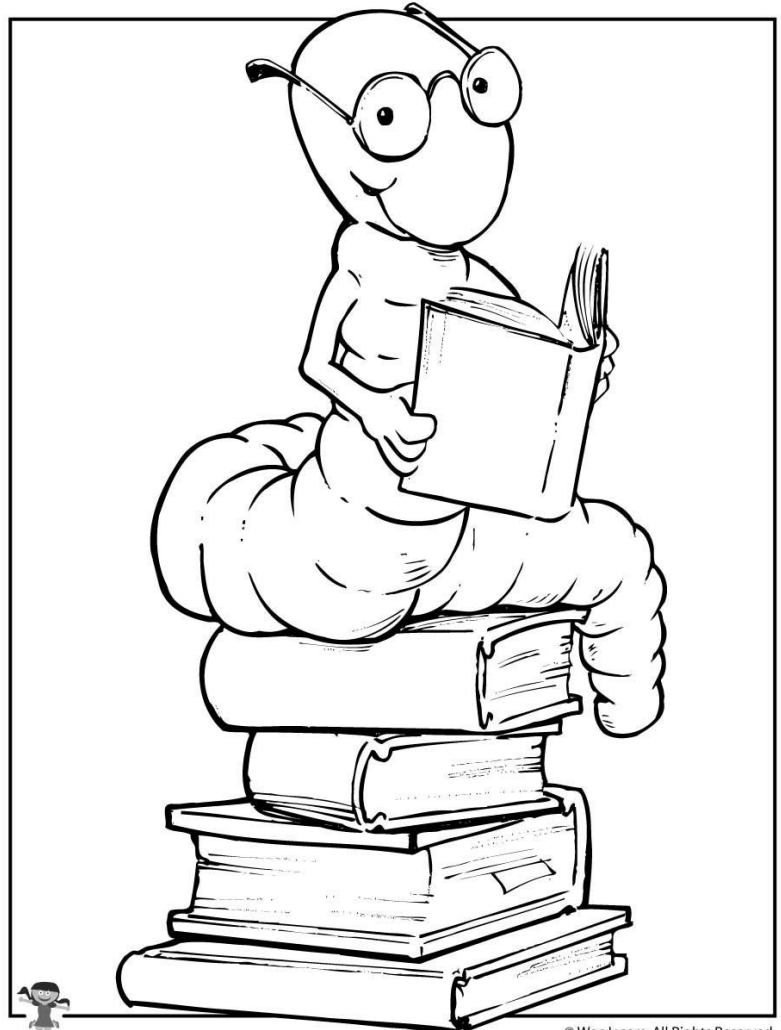

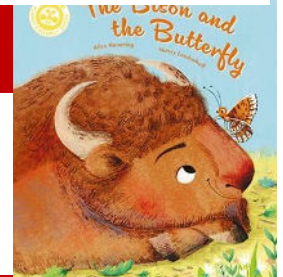


Needs repairs.....
